History of ASIORNA

Currently within the Asian region there is no professional nursing association for perioperative nurses. There are also no networking opportunities for perioperative nurses to come together to exchange information and ideas to enhance and develop perioperative nursing or discuss evidence based practices, patient safety issues as well as their professional voice in the perioperative area.

The first preliminary arrangement meeting was held in Seoul in 2007. The initial challenge for this group (Chairperson of International Committee and Board member of KAORN, 3M) was to organize the first Asian operating room leader's connection with the 2008 Annual Congress of Korea Association of operating Room Nurses (KAORN). The meeting held in Seoul in June 2008 was a crucial one. There were 8 countries present, and they all wanted to formalize the Asian group in 8 different ways. There were several suggestions for the group's official name, and the representatives chose the proposal "Asia-Pacific Operating Room Nurses". ASPORN was born!

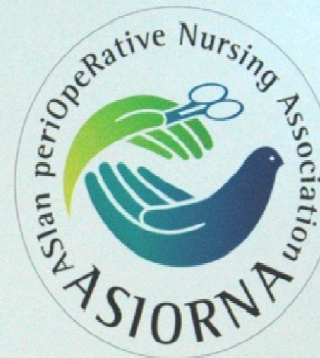
